2010 LESSON PROGRAM & FEE SCHEDULE

Get Hooked on a Positive Addiction...Horses!

INTRODUCTORY RIDER/BEGINNER LESSONS:

- Riders are considered introductory level riders or beginners until they are capable of safely catching, grooming and tacking up their horse, and can ride confidently at all three gaits on
- Sessions last approximately 45 minutes and include tacking, untacking, and grooming
- School horse is provided
- In case of inclement weather, riders will have an unmounted lesson in horsemanship or stable management.
- Group sessions held Tuesday and Thursday at 3:30 & 4:30 during the school year, and Saturday at 9:00. Over the summer, lessons are given on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 9:30 and 10:30 in addition to Saturday at 9:00.

Monthly Lesson Program: 4 lessons per month for \$140 due at the 1st of the month.

Additional lessons are \$35 each

Individual Lesson Program: \$45 per lesson due the day of the lesson

One-Day Mini-Camp (8:00 – 4:00) scheduled in advance includes one mounted lesson, lunch, and a day of learning about horsemanship \$80

The Ridge will provide a helmet for the first two lessons, after that, we ask that every student invest in a quality ASTM/SEI helmet of her own. All students are required to wear a shoe with a heel, preferably paddock boots, and long pants. Long hair should be tied back neatly, and ideally secured with a hairnet. Riders are encouraged to buy riding pants, gloves, and boots as soon as possible. Please ask your instructor to help you with your selections, especially when it comes time to buy show clothes or tack.

Safety is a priority around horses. All students must adhere to rules and procedures of The Ridge. Riders should arrive approximately 10 minutes prior to the lesson time. Parents are encouraged to drop students off or enjoy a cup of coffee in the lounge, but are strongly discouraged from watching lessons, as this is a special time for the student and trainer to work together. Parents are welcome and encouraged to watch at horse shows. In the case of drop-offs, all students must be picked up by 6:00pm on weeknights.

Make up policy: Lessons will only be made up if the rider cancels 24 hrs prior to the lesson. If the weather is extremely dangerous, a staff member will call you to cancel the lesson. However, students will receive a hands-on unmounted lesson in the case of rain. Unless a staff member contacts you, the lesson will go on. To make up a missed lesson, riders may attend another group session. Group session times are listed above. All lessons must be made up within 10 days of the canceled lesson or the make up lesson will be forfeited.
